Workshop Guidelines Nutley Little Theatre

Board approved Feb 25, 2020

- -Workshops are presented at monthly general meetings. (They can be an original or published play, monologue, technical workshop).
- -The workshop is performed on the existing mainstage production set.
- -There is simple tech. Any sound cues used must be provided by the director.
- Furniture can be used for the piece either what is on the stage or down in the construction area. Must be put back afterwards.
- -The director gets their own technician. In the event they cannot, the workshop chair can assist in finding someone.
- -Rehearsal is on the stage the night before the meeting. If that is not good, the director must work out a night with the mainstage production if there is a time.
- -The length of a workshop is not to exceed 30 minutes.
- -Directing a Readers Theatre does not count as director workshop to qualify.
